
1UR-FSE INTAKE > INTAKE MANIFOLD > REMOVAL

1. REMOVE COWL TOP VENTILATOR LOUVER RH

 Remove the 6 clips and cowl top ventilator louver RH.



2. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

CAUTION:

Wait at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent airbag and seat belt pretensioner activation.

NOTICE:


After the engine switch is turned off, the HDD navigation system requires approximately 6 minutes to record various types of memory and settings. As a result, after turning the engine switch off, wait 6 minutes or more before disconnecting the cable from the negative (-) battery terminal.

3. REMOVE V-BANK COVER SUB-ASSEMBLY

a. Using both hands, lift the rear side of the cover upwards to detach the 4 clips labeled B. Then slide the cover toward the front of the vehicle to detach the 2 clips labeled A and remove the V-bank cover.

NOTICE:


- The V-bank cover may be damaged if its front and rear are lifted at the same time.
- When detaching the clips labeled A, be sure to slide the cover toward the front of the vehicle.



4. REMOVE AIR CLEANER INLET COVER


a. Remove the 5 clips A.

b. Lift up the air cleaner inlet cover to detach the 4 clips B, and remove the air cleaner inlet cover.




5. REMOVE ENGINE ROOM SIDE COVER RH

a. Remove the 4 clips and engine room side cover.



6. REMOVE NO. 1 AIR CLEANER INLET


a. Remove the 2 bolts.



- **b.** Hold the air cleaner inlet by the protrusions A and B, and detach the connections.
- **c.** Rotate the No. 1 air cleaner inlet as shown in the illustration to detach the protrusion C.
- **d.** Hold the air cleaner inlet by the protrusions D and E, and detach the


connections.

e. Rotate the No. 1 air cleaner inlet as shown in the illustration to detach the protrusion F.




7. REMOVE NO. 1 ENGINE UNDER COVER

a. Remove the 13 screws, 7 clips and cover.




8. REMOVE FRONT SUSPENSION MEMBER PROTECTOR LOWER

a. Remove the 8 bolts and suspension member protector.



9. REMOVE NO. 2 ENGINE UNDER COVER

a. Remove the 8 bolts and under cover.



10. DRAIN ENGINE COOLANT

CAUTION:


Do not remove the radiator reservoir cap and vent plug while the engine and radiator are still hot. Pressurized, hot engine coolant and steam may be released and cause serious burns.

a. Loosen the radiator drain cock plug.


HINT:

Collect the coolant in a container and dispose of it according to the regulations in your area.

- **b.** Remove the radiator reservoir cap, and using a 6 mm hexagon wrench, remove the vent plug.
- c. Drain coolant.




d. Loosen the 2 cylinder block drain cock plugs.




11. REMOVE INTAKE AIR CONNECTOR PIPE


a. Disconnect the No. 1 and No. 2 ventilation hoses from the intake air connector pipe.



- **b.** for AWD: Using a clip remover, detach the wire harness clamp.
- **c.** Loosen the 3 hose clamps, and remove the intake air connector pipe.
- **a.** Disconnect the throttle motor connector.
- **b.** Remove the 4 bolts and throttle body.




- **C.** Disconnect the No. 4 and No. 5 water by-pass hoses from the throttle body.
- **d.** Remove the gasket from the intake manifold.




13. REMOVE AIR CLEANER ASSEMBLY LH

- a. Disconnect the MAF meter connector.
- **b.** Disconnect the 2 clamps and remove the air cleaner cap.
- **c.** Remove the air cleaner filter element from the air cleaner case.




d. Remove the 2 nuts, clip and air cleaner case.




14. REMOVE AIR CLEANER ASSEMBLY RH

- a. Disconnect the MAF meter connector.
- **b.** Disconnect the 2 clamps and remove the air cleaner cap.
- **c.** Remove the air cleaner filter element from the air cleaner case.



d. Remove the 2 nuts, clip and air cleaner case.



15. DISCONNECT ENGINE WIRE

HINT:

Fix the disconnected harnesses, etc. in place with tape or equivalent so that they do not interfere.

a. for 2WD:


i. Disconnect the engine wire harness connectors.

HINT:

To disconnect the injector driver connectors, push the claw downward and move the lock lever to release the lock.

- ii. Remove the nut and disconnect the engine wire harness from the +B terminal of the generator assembly.
- iii. Using a clip remover, disconnect the 6 engine wire harness clamps.
- iv. Remove the nut and disconnect the engine wire from the fusible link block assembly.
- v. Remove the bolt and disconnect the engine wire harness ground.
- vi. Remove the 4 bolts and 4 engine wire harness clamp brackets.

vii. Remove the 4 nuts and disconnect the engine wire harness.




b. for AWD:

i. Disconnect the engine wire harness connectors.


HINT:

To disconnect the injector driver connectors, push the claw downward and move the lock lever to release the lock.

- **ii.** Remove the nut and disconnect the engine wire harness from the +B terminal of the generator assembly.
- iii. Using a clip remover, disconnect the 6 engine wire harness clamps.
- iv. Remove the nut and disconnect the engine wire from the fusible link block assembly.
- **v.** Remove the bolt and disconnect the engine wire harness ground.
- vi. Remove the 3 bolts and 3 engine wire harness clamp brackets.
- vii. Remove the 4 nuts and disconnect the engine wire harness.




- viii. Disconnect the camshaft timing control valve connector.
 - ix. Disconnect the 4 ignition coil connectors.
 - **x.** Disconnect the 2 VVT sensor connectors.
 - **xi.** Disconnect the fuel pump connector (for high pressure).
- **xii.** Disconnect the No. 8 engine wire connector.




- **xiii.** Remove the 2 bolts and disconnect the clamp and 2 clamp brackets.
- **xiv.** Disconnect the engine coolant temperature sensor connector.
- xv. Disconnect the oil pressure sensor

connector.

- xvi. Disconnect the 2 camshaft timing control motor connectors (for Bank 1).
- **xvii.** Remove the 3 bolts and disconnect the 2 clamps and 3 ground wires.
- **xviii.** Remove the bolt and clamp bracket.



- **xix.** Remove the bolt and disconnect the wire harness bracket.
- **xx.** Disconnect the cooler compressor connector.



16. REMOVE INJECTOR DRIVER


a. Disconnect the 4 injector driver connectors.

HINT:

To disconnect the injector driver connectors, push the claw downward and move the lock lever to release the lock.


b. Disconnect the 2 clamps from the injector driver.

c. Remove the 2 bolts, 2 nuts and injector driver from the intake manifold.




17. REMOVE WATER BY-PASS PIPE SUB-ASSEMBLY

- a. Slide the 4 clamps and disconnect the heater water inlet hose, heater water outlet hose, water inlet hose, and No. 3 water by-pass hose from the water by-pass pipe.
- **b.** Remove the 2 bolts and water bypass pipe.




18. REMOVE PURGE VSV

- **a.** Disconnect the fuel vapor feed hose and No. 2 fuel vapor feed hose.
- **b.** Remove the bolt and purge VSV.



19. REMOVE INTAKE MANIFOLD

a. Disconnect the PCV hose from the intake manifold.



- **b.** Remove the 8 bolts, 2 nuts and intake manifold.
- **c.** Remove the 2 gaskets from the intake manifold.
