INSTRUMENT PANEL REMOVAL




Installation is in the reverse order of removal.

- 1. TILT DOWN AND PULL OUT STEERING WHEEL
- 2. DISCONNECT BATTERY CABLE FROM NEGATIVE (-) TERMINAL
- 3. **REMOVE THESE PARTS**:
- (a) Front seat Torque: 37 N⋅m (375 kgf⋅cm, 27 ft⋅lbf)
- (b) Rear seat cushion
- (c) Rear seat belt lower side bolt
 Torque: 43 N·m (440 kgf·cm, 32 ft·lbf)
- (d) Rear seatback Torque: 18 N·m (185 kgf·cm, 13 ft·lbf)
- (e) Front door scuff plate
- (f) Rear door scuff plate
- (g) Rear seat side garnish
- (h) High mounted stop light
- (i) Speaker grille
- (j) Package tray trim
- (k) Assist grip






6. REMOVE THESE PARTS:

- (a) Parking brake release lever
- (b) Hood lock release lever
- (c) No.1 under cover
- (d) Finish plate
- (e) End pad
- (f) No.1 safety pad
- (g) Coin box
- (h) No.2 heater to register duct
- (i) No.2 under cover
- 7. REMOVE INSTRUMENT PANEL BOX ASSEMBLY (See page RS-23)

HINT: Tape a screwdriver tip before use.


- (a) Using the screwdriver, pry out the glove compartment door finish plate.
- (b) Remove the connector from the glove compartment door finish plate.
- (c) Disconnect the airbag connector.
 NOTICE: When disconnecting the airbag connector, take care not to damage the airbag wire harness.
- (d) Remove the 4 screws and the nut.
- (e) Disconnect the connector, remove the instrument panel box assembly.

8. REMOVE GLOVE COMPARTMENT


- (a) Remove the 2 bolts and the glove compartment door.
- (b) Remove the 3 screws.
- (c) Insert the plastic plate between the upper of compartment to remove it.
- 9. REMOVE STEERING COLUMN (See page SR-13)

10. REMOVE THESE PARTS:

- (a) No.2 register HINT:
 - Tape a screwdriver tip before use.
 - The clip can be found from the register vent.
 - Insert the screwdriver from the register vent, and pry up and push the 2 clips forward of the vehicle.
- (b) Radio with A/C control assembly.








- (d) Combination meter HINT:
 - Tape a screwdriver tip before use.
 - Insert the screwdriver to the 2 clip holes taking care not to damage the instrument panel.
 - Disconnect the meter taking care not to damage the instrument panel.


11. REMOVE CONSOLE BOX THESE PARTS:

- (c) Remove the instrument panel.





- 13. REMOVE INSTRUMENT PANEL REINFORCEMENT
- (a) Remove the 4 nuts and 6 bolts.
- (b) Remove the instrument panel reinforcement.

INSTRUMENT PANEL DISASSEMBLY

Assembly is in the reverse order of disassembly.

- 1. REMOVE THESE PARTS:
- (a) No.1 defroster nozzle garnish
- (b) No.2 side defroster nozzle duct
- (c) No.1 side defroster nozzle duct
- (d) Defroster nozzle assembly
- 2. REMOVE FRONT PASSENGER AIRBAG ASSEMBLY (See page RS-23)
- (a) Remove the 5 nuts, front passenger airbag assembly and front passenger airbag door.
 CAUTION:
 - Do not store the front passenger airbag assembly with the airbag side deployment direction faces down.
 - Never disassemble the front passenger airbag assembly.
