
Lexus Personalized Settings

Your vehicle includes a variety of electronic features that can be programmed to your preferences. Programming of these features is performed once at no charge by your Lexus Dealer provided you obtain the service at the 6 month/5,000-mile scheduled maintenance service.



It is also possible to customize certain vehicle features yourself using the display audio controller.

Vehicles with Display Audio system:



STEP 1 Press the MENU button.




STEP 2 Select using the Remote

STEP 3 Select Vehicle and push knob to select.




STEP 4 Select Vehicle Customization and push knob to select.
