Introduction

Some 2007 model year RX 350 vehicles may display evidence of a small oil leak, located where the Bank 1 cylinder head, engine block, and timing cover meet. Please use the repair procedure below to diagnose and correct this condition.



Repair Procedure

- 1. Inspect the location where the Bank 1 cylinder head, engine block, and timing cover meet for signs of an oil leak.
- 2. Use an oil dye to confirm the source of the oil leak.



- Remove and reseal the timing cover if confirmed leaking.
 Refer to the Technical Information System (TIS), 2007 model year RX 350 Repair Manual:
 - Engine/Hybrid System Lubrication "2GR-FE Lubrication: Oil Pump: Removal"
 - Engine/Hybrid System Lubrication "2GR-FE Lubrication:
 Oil Pump: Installation"
- 4. Confirm that the repair corrected the condition.
