
FAN AND GENERATOR V BELT REPLACEMENT

1. REMOVE AIR CLEANER INLET NO. 1



REMOVE FAN AND GENERATOR V BELT

(a) Loosen the belt tension by turning the belt tensioner counterclockwise, and remove the belt.

(b) Disconnect the belt from the idler pulley No. 2, and remove the belt.


HINT:

The tension pulley has a left-hand thread.

3. INSPECT V-RIBBED BELT TENSIONER ASSY


(a) Remove the V belt from the tensioner pulley. Then check that nothing gets caught the tensioner by turning it clockwise and counterclockwise.

When a malfunction exists, replace the tensioner.



INSTALL FAN AND GENERATOR V BELT

- (a) Set the belt to everything except the idler pulley No. 2 as shown in the illustration.
- (b) Loosen the belt by turning the belt tensioner counterclockwise.
- (c) Connect the belt to the idler pulley No. 2.



(d) After a new belt has been installed, check that the indicator line is within the B range.

5. INSTALL AIR CLEANER INLET NO. 1
